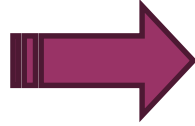

How can we learn about the Second World War? Personal stories.

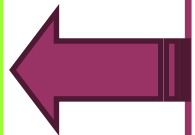


Year 6 - Summer 1 A Child's War (continued)
