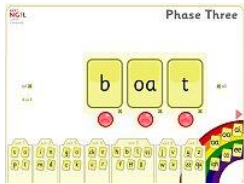
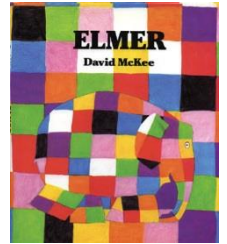


Home-Learning in the Reception Year

Children who are supported at home are more successful at school. Here are some suggestions to help with your child's journey through the Reception year.

Talk to your child about what they enjoy, have been learning and have shown an interest in.

Share a book with your child, talking about what is happening in the story.



Help your child to recognise letters by their speech sounds (phonics).

Encourage your child to mark-make and represent their name. Ask them to help you make a list.



Count as you walk, climb stairs, go shopping.

Do a number hunt- where are all the places we find numbers? Read the numbers and talk about which numbers are more/ which are less.



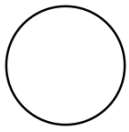
Let your children handle coins and identify their values.

When cooking or baking with your child talk about measuring the ingredients.

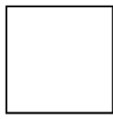
Look for shapes in the environment- which shapes are the same? How are the shapes different?

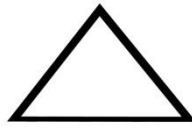
Square



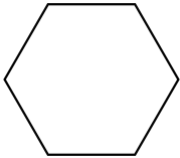
Rectangle



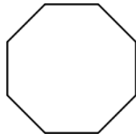
Triangle



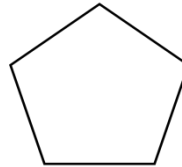
Hexagon

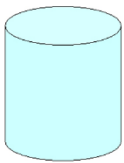

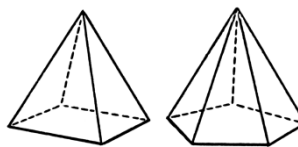

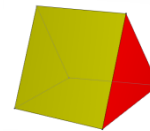

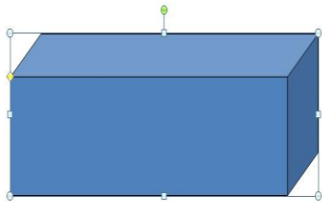
