Engage

We will start our topic of 'Our World' by revisiting everything we know already about plants. We will then look at what plants need to survive and the different parts of a flowering plant. We will conduct investigations to find out the conditions that plants need to survive and how by changing these, the plants grow differently. We will also look at how water is transported within plants.



Year 3 – Summer 2
