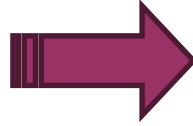


Engage

What are natural disasters and the impacts?*

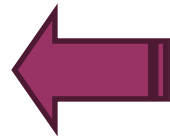


Year 3 – Spring 1 Topic: Rocks, Relics and Rumbles

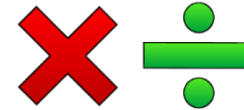
The children will learn about:
