

History Curriculum Overview 2022-23

Our aims are for children to develop a range of skills and understanding linked to the National Curriculum Subject of History and in particular the following:

- For all children to have an understanding of chronology and changes in time from the earliest times to present day.
- Looking at how key figures and events have shaped and changed the world and looking at a range of different civilisations.
- Looking at changes within living memory and events beyond living memory both nationally and globally.
- To learn key historical vocabulary and historical enquiry skills, how the use of artefacts help us in identifying what has happened in the past.
- To be able to use a wide range of resources to find out evidence and develop written narratives about key events and to develop debating skills when comparing the past with the present.
