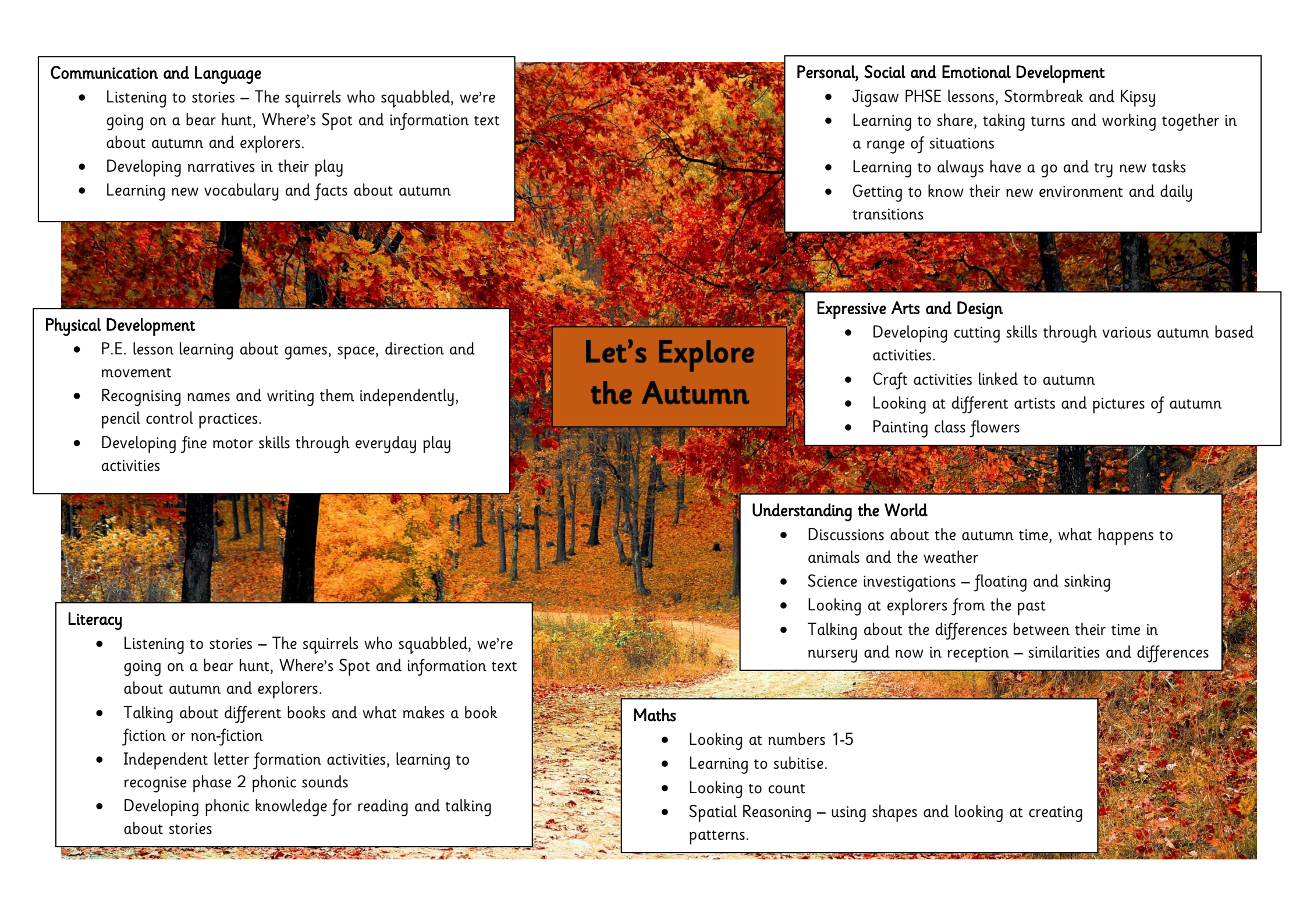




Communication and Language

Let's Explore the Autumn

Understanding the World

- Discussions about the autumn time, what happens to animals and the weather
- Science investigations – floating and sinking
- Looking at explorers from the past
- Talking about the differences between their time in nursery and now in reception – similarities and differences

Maths

- Looking at numbers 1-5
- Learning to subitise.
- Looking to count
- Spatial Reasoning – using shapes and looking at creating patterns.
