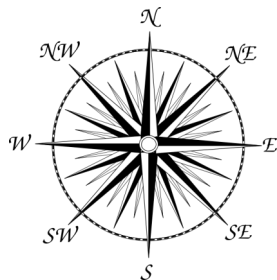

Geography:

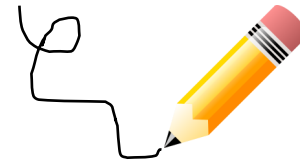
- ♦ Locating places on a map
