## Engage

- Using different ways to go on a journey, scooter, bike,
- Talk about holidays- suitcase and clothes you might take on holiday - share story penguin on holiday
- Share photos of places we have visited on holiday, use UK map, world map and globe to see where we have visited

## Develop

- Looking at different animals from around the world—create different habitats for them
- Story 'Tanka Tanks Skunk - Steve Webb. Clap the rhythms as we read
- Handa's Surprise count the animals, talk about the journey she went on. Sorting animals, number lines, number cards.
- Introduce globes and a variety of maps. Have discussions about where we live, countries they have visited or where relatives may live. Introduce Google Earth and explore some countries around the world.
- Create a large journey/map— use positional language
- Learning to say hello in different languages
- Patterns , 2d shape printing
- Talk about and try different foods from around the world

## Innovate

- Plan a trip for an exciting destination (create a passport, choose a destination, what do we need to take on the trip, what animals might we see, make a post card to send to someone.
