



Code of Conduct on School Premises

By entering school Premises you agree to following school procedures and policies as well as reasonable requests from staff.

School Aim:

That all staff, parents and children are entitled to a safe and protective environment in which to work. Behaviour that will cause harassment, alarm or distress to users of the premises is contrary to the aims of the school.

To achieve this, the school will strive to:

- Ensure that all members of the school community treat each other with respect.

The school expectation is:

- That all adults set a good example to children at all times, showing them how to get along with all members of the school and the wider community.
- That no members of staff, parents or children are the victims of abusive behaviour or open to threats from other adults on the school premises.
- School will challenge, and deal with any behaviour that falls below school expectations.

Serious incidents:

- Physical attacks and threatening behaviour, abusive or insulting language verbal or written, to staff, governors, parents and carers, children and other users of the school premises will not be tolerated and may result in withdrawal of permission to be on school premises.
- Any parent who is asked to leave the school premises will have the right to appeal the decision by writing to the Chair of Governors.

Please note:

- Any incidents on school premises will be recorded.

Responsibilities:

- It is the responsibility of the Headteacher and Governors to monitor and review this statement.
