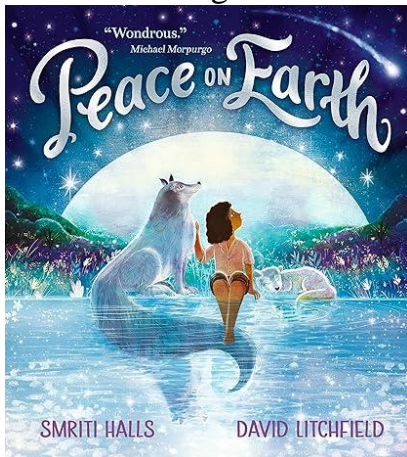
Another great week at Balliol, Year 4 enjoyed their trip to the Higgins Museum and their behaviour was, as ever, a credit to you as parents and to the school.
