
Welcome Back

We are looking forward to welcoming all of the children back to school on Monday, we have been working hard over the summer to prepare the classrooms and ensure that everything is ready for a new term and new school year at Balliol.

Please make sure you have read our 'Getting Ready for September' information in the newsletter section of the school website for information about equipment and timings of the school day.

We will be continuing the one-way system around the school grounds for all parents and children. This ensures safety for all.

We remind all parents that we will not be allowing children to walk to the school gate to wait to be collected (this includes older children accompanying younger children). This is for safeguarding reasons. All children should be collected from the space outside the classrooms unless they are in Year5/6 and have signed permission to walk home.

The school dinner menu for the Autumn term is on the school website. If you have a child moving from Year 2 into Year 3 please be aware that they are no longer entitled to Universal Free School Meals and meals will need to be paid in advance through Caterlink unless you are entitled to income related Free School Meals.

If you require a link to your Caterlink account to make payment. Please email the school office.

On Monday morning there will be several staff outside the classrooms and in the outside areas to support and direct you, please speak to them if you have any questions.

Friday Provision. This is a childcare provision in place on a Friday afternoon for those parents who are working and do not have any alternative childcare available. Please be aware that if this is not booked in advance through the booking system, we will not be able to accommodate children as we need to ensure that our supervision ratios are sufficient.

Communication

If you need to speak to a class teacher, please continue to use class emails to do this, all classes have the same format using the class name at the beginning:

Uniform

All children will be expected to wear school uniform which includes black shoes. Multi-coloured shoes/trainers are not acceptable as part of the day to day school uniform.

On PE days the children should come to school in their PE kit. This should be black/blue shorts or joggers, a white/blue t-shirt and a black or blue warm top.
